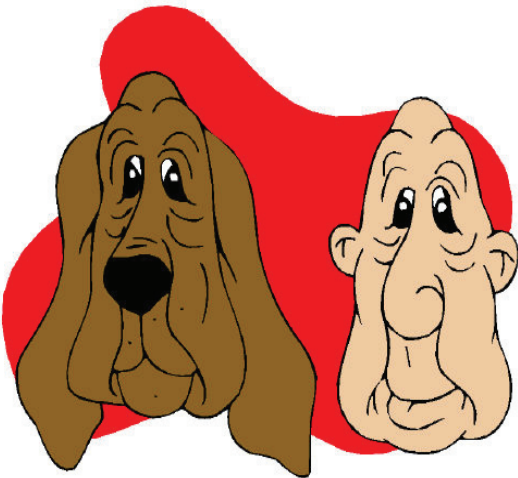

Frequently Asked Questions

What can I donate?

Donate autos, trucks, motorcycles, vans, commercial vehicles, jet skis, snowmobiles, motor homes, buses, and even boats. It doesn't even have to run.

Is my donation tax deductible?

ElderPet is a non-profit corporation, so your donation should be tax deductible. You will receive a formal letter from ElderPet certifying that you have donated the item. Please note that all vehicles are sold for the benefit of the ElderPet. ElderPet does not take possession of the vehicle. Since each case is different, it is best to consult your tax advisor for details.

Can I donate a vehicle that hasn't run in years?

Yes, we are able to accept most vehicles running or not - even if they have been totaled.

Is there any cost to me?

No, we (Donationline) pays for towing your vehicle.

What do I need to do to make a donation?

From our website, submit the Vehicle Donation Form via e-mail or call us Toll-free anytime at 1-877-227-7487. You will be contacted by the towing company within two business days.

When can I call?

We have an operator taking calls 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

I live in a small town, can you still pick up my vehicle?

No problem. Our towing services is available nationwide.
